

CHICKEN FOOT

TEXAS GOOD SAM

GAME

- 1) Chicken Foot uses a Double Nine Domino set, five players at each table
- 2) Game consists of (10) hands.
- 3) Each hand begins with a double starting with the double nine. Succeeding hands in descending order begin with 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, and blank. The double blank hand is the final hand of the game.

PLAY

- 1) Each player draws eleven (11) dominoes
- 2) Player with the double nine plays the domino to begin the game. Succeeding hands continue in the same manner, double 8, double 7, etc.
- 3) Play continues to the left.
- 4) All four (4) sides of the beginning double must be completed prior to any other move
- 5) When a player cannot make a move, they "pass" their turn.
- 6) All doubles played after the beginning double are placed perpendicular and "CHICKEN FOOT" is announced.
- 7) When "CHICKEN FOOT" is on the board, three (3) dominoes must be played off it prior to any other move.
- 8) Tap domino on table when you have only one (1) left.
- 9) Hand ends when a player plays all eleven (11) dominoes, or when NO player has a move.

SCORING

- 1) Players with un-played dominoes add up the total value.
- 2) Double blank counts 20, all others face value.
- 3) Player with lowest cumulative score of all ten hands played wins the game
